



How do I transfer my SBCC scholarship if I am transferring to a 4 year University, State, or Vocational School?

If you are transferring to a four-year college or university or an advanced vocational school in the 2020-2021 school year, the scholarship you are awarded must be transferable as set out in the requirements of each scholarship.

If the scholarship is not transferable, you are not eligible receive it. If you are transferring to a different community college, you are not eligible to receive it.

To have your scholarship sent to your transfer institution, you must provide the following information via mail, Pipeline email, or in person, to the Scholarship Coordinator by Friday, November 20, 2020, for Fall semester transfers and Friday, April 16, 2021, for Spring semester transfers. If you will not be able to submit the information by the date above, you must notify the Scholarship Coordinator in writing, in order to not lose eligibility of your scholarship.

- ✓ Proof of Enrollment – Fall 2020 schedule of classes with number of units visible and student’s full name (or Spring 2021 schedule of classes if a spring transfer)
- ✓ SBCC Student ID Number (K#)
- ✓ Name of Transfer School and your Student ID Number there

Information can be submitted one of three ways: (1) Drop off in person, (2) Mailed to the address below, or, (3) emailed from your Pipeline email to the Scholarship Coordinator email address below. Upon receipt of all requested information below, funds are transferred to your transfer school’s Financial Aid Office within 3-4 weeks.
